- Contributed \$3,000 to Eastport Elem. School for their summer camp program.
- Contributed \$1,100 to help support the very successful Eastport Girls Club and also provides many volunteers.
- Co-sponsored the summer concert series at the Annapolis Maritime Museum.
- Provided funding for the flowers on the bridge all summer.
- Purchased and installed 20 new Neighborhood Watch signs.
- Planned and staged two Mayoral Candidate forums in the fall elections.
- Purchased over 100 backpacks for at risk youth in Eastport Terrace/Harbor House.
- Provided financial assistance to Creating Communities which fed over 145 people at Thanksgiving in our community.
- Contributed to the 50th Anniversary Celebration and Gala for the Seafarers Yacht Club, in Eastport, the oldest African American Yacht Club in the country.
- Provided money to install a sensory garden at Eastport Elementary School.
- Contributed \$500 to PTA at Eastport Elementary School to offset lost parking revenue from Boat Show.
- Wrote letter of support to Planning Commission on Colonial Nursery School.
- Worked closely with EBA to have Eastport Business fair at one of our ECA meetings.
- Paid for two E-cruisers for Midnight Madness to support Eastport and downtown businesses.
- Contributed \$1,000 to Annapolis Police Department Fish Camp.
- Donated \$1,140 to Tyler Elementary for their camp program.
- Supported with donations and volunteers a weekly mentoring/tutoring in public housing.
- Contributed \$1,320 for Eastport Terrace and Harbor House Family dinners one day per month. Also provided volunteers to serve food and interact with the children.
- Showed the film *Pip and Zastrow* to the community and provided refreshments.
- Conducted annual Home and Garden Tour, which raises \$5,000 plus.
